NZ BOOK INDUSTRY AWARDS 2021

AWARD INFORMATION EMERGING PUBLISHER OF THE YEAR

Who should enter?

Publishing stars who have worked in the industry for five years or less as at 31 March 2021 and work in book publishing in New Zealand.

Criteria

The judges are looking for someone who has made a positive impact on the New Zealand book industry, and who has the potential to achieve even more. They will have displayed a passion for the industry and excellence in their work.

What to submit

- A completed entry form.
- A single PDF (5 pages max.) which addresses the above criteria. Note: examples must be from 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021.
 - Some of the things you could include are:
 - Details on books, projects and acquisitions.
 - Any award success.
 - Testimonials e.g. from authors and colleagues.
 - Evidence of enthusiasm for and engagement with the wider publishing industry.

Entry fee

This year there is no entry fee for nominations for staff of businesses that are members of PANZ. Non-members may enter for a fee of \$100+gst.

The prize

The winner will be presented with a trophy and certificate at the Awards Dinner on Saturday 21 August. Winners may be called on to do media interviews in the weeks following the Awards to talk about their win.

How to enter

Nominations would usually come from the individual's employer or colleagues, but publishers may nominate themselves.
