

NZ BOOK INDUSTRY AWARDS 2024

AWARD INFORMATION

PANZ EMERGING PUBLISHER OF THE YEAR

Who should enter?

Publishing stars who have worked in the industry for five years or less as at 31 March 2024 and currently work in book publishing in New Zealand.

Criteria

The judges are looking for an exceptional publishing professional whose work shows evidence of the following (weightings are in brackets):

- Has made a direct and positive impact on the New Zealand book industry, their company or their list **(40%)**
- Has the potential to achieve even more **(20%)**
- Has displayed a passion for the industry **(10%)**
- Have excellent working relationships **(20%)**
- Shows excellence in their work **(10%)**

What to submit

- A [completed entry form](#).
- In the form the nominee will be asked to concisely outline the reasons for this nomination, with specific reference to the above criteria and to the **impact** the nominee and their work has had. Note: examples must be from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024.
- Some of the things that could be included are:
 - Details of acquisitions, list development, books and other projects and their impact.
 - Any awards success or other recognition.
 - Testimonials from authors, booksellers and colleagues.
 - Evidence of enthusiasm for – and engagement with – the wider publishing industry.

Entry fee

There is no entry fee for nominations for staff of organisations that are members of PANZ. Non-members may enter for a fee of \$100 (+GST).

The prize

The winner will be presented with a certificate at the Awards Dinner on Saturday 3 August 2024. Winners may be called on to do media interviews in the weeks following the Awards to talk about their win (and to promote New Zealand book industry generally).

How to enter

Nominations would usually come from an individual's employer or colleagues, but individuals may nominate themselves.
