

# NZ BOOK INDUSTRY AWARDS 2020

## AWARD INFORMATION

### YOUNG NZ PUBLISHER OF THE YEAR

#### Who should enter?

Rising publishing stars who are aged 35 or under as at 31 May 2020 and work in book publishing in New Zealand.

#### Criteria

The judges are looking for a young person who has made a positive impact on the New Zealand book industry, and who has the potential to achieve even more. They will have displayed a passion for the industry and excellence in their work.

#### What to submit

- A completed entry form
- A single PDF (5 pages max.) which addresses the above criteria. Note: examples must be from 01 April 2019 to 31 May 2020.
- Some of the things you could include are:
  - Testimonials – from authors, colleagues and employers
  - Evidence of contributions – this could include photographs of displays and events; screenshots of social media, etc.
  - Evidence of enthusiasm and passion for books and the publishing industry, this could be examples of reviews and blogs, event participation etc.

#### Entry fee

This year there is no entry fee for nominations for staff of businesses that are members of Booksellers NZ and/or PANZ. Non-members may enter for a fee of \$100+gst.

#### The prize

The winner will be presented with a trophy and certificate at the Awards Dinner on Saturday 22 August. Booksellers NZ is looking to capitalise on the positive media coverage received so far this year, with a big push for profiles of winners in print and broadcast media.

#### How to enter

Nominations would usually come from the individual's employer or colleagues, but publishers may nominate themselves.
